

1. Select your desired fencing style, color, height and width (either 6' or 8').
2. If a gate is desired, select style, color, height and width (either $3^{\prime}, 4^{\prime}$ or $8^{\prime}$ ).
3. Select your desired fence post cap style and color.
4. Measure area you wish to enclose as well as gate location.
5. Draw a layout to determine the number of fence panels, posts \& gates you will need.

NOTE: If needed, fencing can be shortened such as cutting a 6 ' length down to $5^{\prime}$.
6. Based on your layout, enter the number of your needs below:
